This is an annual observance that dates back to the early days of our nation's history.

In the early days, various colonies and states observed days of fasting, prayer, and thanksgiving during times of crisis or celebration. These observances were often called by colonial governors or state legislatures and were seen as opportunities for the community to come together in worship and reflection.

The modern National Day of Prayer traces its origins to the mid-20th century. In 1952, a joint resolution of the United States Congress was signed into law by President Harry S. Truman, declaring an annual National Day of Prayer. The resolution called on the President to set aside a suitable day each year, other than a Sunday, for the American people to turn to God in prayer and meditation.

In 1988, President Ronald Reagan signed into law a bill designating the first Thursday in May as the official

observance of the National Day of Prayer. This legislation reaffirmed the nation's reliance on prayer and encouraged Americans to seek divine guidance in their personal and collective lives.

Since then, the National Day of Prayer has become an annual tradition, with events and gatherings held across the country. It is a time for believers to come together in prayer, seeking guidance, healing, and unity.

The history of the National Day of Prayer reflects the enduring role of religion in American life and the nation's commitment to spiritual values.

From its colonial origins to its modern observance, the National Day of Prayer serves as a reminder of the importance of faith, community, and unity in the American experience.

The establishment of the State of Israel in 1948 marked a pivotal moment in the history of the Middle East.

Israel's State emerged from a complex historical backdrop shaped by centuries of Jewish diaspora, and the aftermath of World War II.

The roots of the Zionist movement, which sought to establish a homeland for the Jewish people, can be traced back to the late 19th century amid growing anti-Semitism in Europe.

SUPPORT CTN USING YOUR IRA

Giving to non-profits from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) can indeed be a beneficial strategy for both the donor and the charitable organization.



Here is why it can be a great idea:

One of the primary advantages of donating directly from your IRA is the potential for tax savings.

If you are at least 70½ years old, you can make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) directly from your IRA to a qualified charitable organization. The amount donated through a QCD can count towards your required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year, and it is excluded from your taxable income.

This can be advantageous if you do not need the full amount of your RMD for living expenses and want to minimize your tax liability.

It also reduces your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI). This can

have numerous benefits, including potentially reducing your Medicare premiums, minimizing the impact of the incomerelated monthly adjustment amount (IRMAA) for Medicare Part B and Part D, and lowering the threshold for deducting medical expenses.

Giving from your IRA also empowers you to support causes you care about, such as the Christian Television Network. It is simple and convenient, and making charitable donations directly from your IRA can be a straightforward process.

We have a planned giving expert at CTN, Ms. Sharon Seward. She can help you to facilitate IRA distributions to CTN.

The government encourages philanthropy and supports the vital work of non-profit organizations by providing tax incentives for charitable donations from IRAs.

However, it is important to consult with a tax advisor or financial planner before making charitable donations from your IRA to ensure that it aligns with your overall financial goals and tax situation.
