MAKING A BIG IMPACT HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER

Here are four easy ways you can make an even greater impact to broadcast God-honoring, family-friendly TV and save on taxes:



IRA — If you're 70½ years or older, you can make a qualified charitable donation (QCD) of up to \$105,000 directly from your traditional IRA without adding a penny to your taxable income. You'll also get an income deduction for your charitable gift whether or not you itemize your taxes. If you are age 73 or older, this also counts toward your required minimum distribution.



APPRECIATED ASSETS — Receive a charitable giving deduction for the fair market value of the asset (up to 30% of your adjusted gross income) if you have owned the asset (stocks, bonds, property, rental, or vacation home) more than 12 months. You will likely avoid the capital gains tax on the appreciation if you sold the asset.



DONOR ADVISED FUND (DAF) — Now is a great time to distribute grants from your DAF to CTN. These funds are already set aside for ministry and your select charities, so you can give freely
